## THE BIG RED DOG™

CLIFFORD THE BIG RED DOG™ is loved by children across the country as well as teachers! PBS and Scholastic are pleased to announce off-air record rights for the educational use of CLIFFORD for 1 year from each broadcast of each program.

Each half-hour episode of CLIFFORD features two stories, separated by a brief "story time" segment, in which Emily reads a book to Clifford. The show closes with a segment about one of "Clifford's Big Ideas."

Each story segment below includes one of Clifford's 10 Big Ideas as a guiding theme. Since children represent such a wide variety of social and emotional experiences and each story segment has so much to offer, each child may see in each story something just for themselves.

### EPISODE 101

#### 101a My Best Friend

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Emily decides she must find something "special" for Show and Tell. After an exhaustive search of Bridwell Island for the perfect thing, she learns that sometimes the best things in life are right under your nose.

#### 101b Cleo's Fair Share

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Share

Cleo gets a new toy and doesn't want to share it. She soon learns that it's not so much fun playing with a new toy without your friends.

### EPISODE 102

#### 102a Special Delivery

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

Clifford accidentally breaks a present he was supposed to deliver for Emily, then allows Cleo to convince him to try to hide the fact from Emily. But Clifford learns that it's best to be honest, right from the start.



### 102b A Ferry Tale

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

After Emily grooms Clifford in preparation for Prize Pooch Magazine's "Dog of the Year" contest, he is expected to "stay clean" until the judge, Lily LaValley, arrives. Clifford struggles to stay clean, but getting dirty gets the better of him. In the end, Clifford learns that Emily loves him, clean or dirty, unconditionally.

## EPISODE 103

### 103a And Birdy Makes Three

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Share

When Emily finds a baby bird, she decides to take care of it until it learns to fly. Clifford learns that, even when she's busy with other things, Emily never stops loving him.

### 103b Home is Where the Fun is

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

First, Emily feels jealous that Jetta gets to go see the amazing Titanic Tower in the exciting big city. But she soon learns there are some pretty amazing things right in her own backyard.

## EPISODE 104

### 104a Clifford's Carnival

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Work Together

Everyone, including Clifford, must work as a team to puy on this year's Fall Carnival. Jetta sees herself as a boss rather than a team player but soon learns the importance of being a team player.

### 104b Clifford's Doggy Reunion

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

Clifford and Emily are excited — Cousin Laura and her dog Rex are coming to visit! They haven't seen each other since Clifford was a little puppy! When they arrive, Emily and Clifford find Laura and Rex are different than they remember them. They learn that people change and adjustments have to be made.

## EPISODE 105

### 105a Great Race

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

T-Bone finds himself in a contest with Mac. He doesn't win, but he does his best. T-Bone learns that you don't have to win to feel good — you just have to do your very best.

### 105b Tummy Trouble

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Responsible

Clifford and his dog friends convince themselves that it's okay to eat lots of treats as long as they've done special things to deserve them. All three learn that too much of a good thing can be bad.

## EPISODE 106

### 106a Cleo Comes to Town

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

In flashback, we see how Cleo shook everybody up when she first moved to Birdwell Island. T-Bone learns to accept her as a new friend, and how to share an old friend (Clifford) with a new one.

### 106b False Friends

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

When Cleo gets a new doggie playground and suddenly Macis her new best friend, she starts ignoring Clifford and T-Bone! But Cleo soon learns that good friends stick by you through thick and thin.

## EPISODE 107

### 107a Clifford and the Beanstalk

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Responsible

Emily works hard to prepare for her audition for the lead in the school play, but loses the role to Jetta, who worries more about what she'll wear than about learning her lines. Emily steps in and plays the lead role at the last minute, and Jetta learns that hard work and preparation are what make you successful.

### 107b Itchy Patch

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Clifford is itching like crazy but tries hard to stop when he hears Emily say she'll take him to the vet if he keeps it up. With the help of Cleo and T-Bone, Clifford tries every trick to conceal his discomfort to avoid a trip to the doctor! But Clifford soon learns the value of trust in an unknown situation.

## EPISODE 108

### 108a A New Friend

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

There's a new dog in town — and he has three legs. Clifford, Cleo and T-Bone really like KC, but they feel uncomfortable and unsure of how to act around him. One minute Clifford is totally overcompensating for KC; the next, Cleo is fretting that his "difference" might be contagious! Ultimately, the dogs learn the differently-abled want to be friends just like everyone else.

### 108b Stormy Weather

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Clifford's talent for digging seems to be disrupting every one in town. When a big storm comes in, his deficit becomes an asset. Clifford learns there's an appropriate time and place for his talents to be expressed.

## EPISODE 109

### 109a Circus Stars

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

When Clifford's hero, Gordo the elephant, star of the circus, comes down with a cold, Clifford volunteers to step in and help out. Starstruck Clifford learns that stars are just regular people and, like everyone else, they some times need a helping hand.

### 109b Limelight Fright

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Work Together

When Emily and Charley recruit the dogs to help them with a show, scene-stealing Cleo is surprised to discover she has stage fright! But she learns that the support of friends can help you work through a problem.

## EPISODE 110

### 110a To Catch a Bird

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

When Jetta's trophy and locket are missing, all fingers and paws point to Emily — except for Clifford's! The dogs, led by Clifford, finally prove Emily's innocence, and Clifford learns the value of having faith in a friend.

### 110b The Best Party Ever

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

Jetta ridicules Emily for not planning enough exciting activities for her birthday party so Charley convinces Emily not to invite her. But Emily realizes that Jetta's feelings were hurt and invites her after all. Besides, with Clifford at the party, there's always more than enough excitement — even for Jetta!

## EPISODE 111

### 111a Come Back, Mac

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

Mac tears one of Jetta's favorite sweaters and feels so terrible he runs away. Clifford and friends seek him out and convince him to return and face the music. Mac learns that he's more important to Jetta than her sweater, and facing up is the wise thing to do.

### 111b Boo!

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

It's Halloween, and Jetta can't stop bragging about how brave she is. When the whole town gets a little spooked after watching a scary ghost movie, Jetta learns that it's okay to have fears, admit them out loud, and let the people who care about you know about them.

## EPISODE 112

### 112a Little Clifford

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Kind

In this flashback story, we learn how Emily and Clifford got together and how Emily's unconditional love changed the runt of the litter into the biggest dog around!

### 112b Welcome to Birdwell

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

This flashback episode tells the story of the day the Howards moved to Birdwell Island. The town is full of preconceived ideas about how "a big dog can mean big problems" for the island, but they soon learn that Clifford has much to offer and they shouldn't make assumptions before knowing the facts.

## EPISODE 113

### 113a The Dog Who Cried Woof

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

After overhearing Samuel tell the kids a scary story about Whiffy the Skunk Ghost, Clifford and T-Bone get a bit spooked. Cleo takes the opportunity to play a series of naughty tricks on them, then finds them not believing her when she really needs them! She learns that it isn't nice to play tricks on people.

### 113b Doing the Right Thing

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

When T-Bone inadvertently "steals" a squeak toy, he experiences a guilt-induced dream where his conscience tries to show him the right thing to do. T-Bone listens and learns that it's always best to do the right thing.

## EPISODE 114

### 114a Leaf of Absence

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Responsible

T-Bone asks Clifford to keep an eye on a pile of leaves he has collected, but Clifford simply can't resist jumping into them. When the wind picks up, Clifford realizes he hasn't taken his responsibility seriously enough and spends the afternoon re-collecting the pile. T-Bone is truly grateful when he returns to see his leaves are intact. Clifford learns the importance of keeping a promise.

### 114b Nobody's Perfect

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

It's Silly Sports Day at school, and everyone is looking forward to seeing Charley master yet another athletic feat. But Charley is having a messy time trying to learn how to "Jiggly Juggle"! He wants to throw in the towel, but learns that you don't have to be the very best at something to enjoy doing it!

## EPISODE 115

### 115a Teacher's Pet

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

The dogs go to school for the first time, and T-Bone worries that he won't be able to keep up with the rest of the class. He works hard and pays close attention to the teacher's directions. In the end, his efforts are rewarded.

### 115b Islander of the Year

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

The library sponsors an essay contest for Islander of the Year, and the children all submit their ideas. But somehow, all their tales include Clifford — who is ultimately chosen as the winner! Sometimes a winner is the one you'd least expect to succeed.

## EPISODE 116

### 116a The Ears Have It

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

Clifford and Cleo are excited about the town's upcoming celebration complete with a parade and fireworks! But they notice that T-Bone isn't quite as enthusiastic, and soon learn he is afraid of the loud noises at all the festivities. T-Bone learns that the support of good friends can help you manage feelings of fear.

### 116b Clifford's Big Surprise

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

Everyone is too busy to play with Clifford because they are busy planning a surprise party for him! On his own, Clifford learns that playing by yourself can be fun — but so is a party with all of your friends!

## EPISODE 117

### 117a Tough Enough?

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Thinking that it'll make him more appealing to Sheriff Lewis, T-Bone decides to "toughen up." T-Bone eventually learns that everyone loves him just the way he is.

### 117b Stars in Your Eyes

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect, Be a Good Friend

Charley gets a new telescope and offers to bring it to Emily Elizabeth's "space" theme party. When Jetta mentions that the telescope might get damaged at the party, Charley changes his mind. Thinking his friends won't want him at the party without his telescope, he decides to stay home. In the end, Charley realizes his friends like him for who he is rather than what he has.

## EPISODE 118

### 118a Mac's Secret Dog Club

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Kind, Be a Good Friend

Mac starts a club and tries to exclude T-Bone. When Cleo and Clifford refuse to join without T-Bone, Mac gets lonely being the only member of such an exclusive club.

### 118b The Dog Park

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Share

It's a beautiful day at the park, the birds are singing, the sun is shining, and the dogs are playing — much to Mr. Bleakman's annoyance! Mr. Bleakman manages to make the park off limits to dogs — only to discover that he misses them when they're gone.

## EPISODE 119

### 119a Fluffed Up Cleo

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself — but not so much that you brag about it...

When Cleo wins the esteemed honor of Fluffiest Dog of Birdwell Island, it's all she can talk about! Clifford and T-Bone try to tolerate the newborn star, but it takes a lot of patience. When Cleo gets a dose of her own medicine from Mac, she learns it's okay to be proud of an accomplishment, but to stay respectful of others.

### 119b Team Spirit

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Kind, Play Fair

After Jetta tells Vaz his poor soccer skills are holding back their team, Vaz tries to sit out the rest of the game. In the end, Jetta and Vaz learn that being part of a team is more important than winning.

## EPISODE 120

### 120a Clifford on Parade

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Work Together

Emily and Charley are having a hard time deciding what kind of float to make for the annual Birdwell Parade. With a little help from Clifford, they learn the importance of compromise.

### 120b Follow the Leader

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Play Fair

Cleo has a hard time giving up her role as leader in a game of Follow the Leader, but soon learns that playing with friends is more fun when everyone cooperates and takes turns.

## EPISODE 121

### 121a Good-Bye T-Bone

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

Clifford and Cleo misunderstand a conversation they overhear, and think T-Bone is moving away. They vow to make T-Bone's last day on Birdwell Island extra special. They eventually learn to listen to a whole story before jumping to conclusions—but the good friends enjoy a truly special day nonetheless!

### 121b The Truth about Dogs and Cats

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

When two cats "move in" to the tree next door to T-Bone, the dogs try everything to get rid of them, but they soon discover that they have no real reason not to like the cats. The dogs learn that, just because individuals are different, it doesn't mean they can't be friends.

## EPISODE 122

### 122a The Big Sleepover

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Work Together

Emily is going off the Island for a night and asks Charley to baby-sit for Clifford. The day goes pretty well, but when night falls, Clifford really misses Emily. The whole town bands together to get the big red dog through the night and learns that they can accomplish anything if they put their minds to it!

### 122b Dog for a Day

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Fed up with his "responsibilities," Charley decides he would like to lead a dog's life—no chores, no school, no problems. But in a hilarious dream he learns that he likes being just who he is.

## EPISODE 123

### 123a T-Bone, Dog about Town

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

A cute little poodle named Mimi comes to Birdwell Island on vacation, and T-Bone gets a crush. He starts trying to be the kind of dog he thinks she will like, but learns that it's always best to just be yourself.

### 123b Clifford's Big Heart

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

Clifford works hard to try to make Emily the perfect Valentine to show her how much he loves her. In the end, he learns that it's his presence, not presents, that means the most to Emily Elizabeth.

## EPISODE 124

### 124a Who Me, Jealous?

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Mrs. Diller is taking care of Susie, her sister's puppy, for the weekend. Does Mrs. Diller like the cute little puppy better than she likes Cleo? Cleo determines to "out-cute" the puppy and win back Mrs. Diller's affection. But she soon learns that Mrs. Diller thinks Cleo is perfect just the way she is.

### 124b A Bunny in a Haystack

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Responsible

When Emily brings home the class bunny, Clifford, Cleo and T-Bone learn what a big responsibility it is to take care of a pet!

## EPISODE 125

### 125a Clothes Don't Make the Dog

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

T-Bone gets a new sweater, but when Mac teases him about it he gets too embarrassed to wear it. He soon learns that it's not what you wear that makes others like you.

### 125b Short-Changed

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

When family friend Skyscraper Jackson visits, Emily worries that Clifford prefers the attentions of a super-tall basketball player to the attentions of a short little girl. Emily soon learns that love comes in all sizes.

## EPISODE 126

### 126a The Kibble Crook

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

T-Bone can't resist sneaking a bite—well, okay the whole bowl—of Cleo's new dog food. When Cleo gets upset, T-Bone blames it on another dog and sends our fearless friends on a wild goose chase. T-Bone ultimately learns to take responsibility for his own mistakes.

### 126b Screaming for Ice Cream

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

Charley and Emily Elizabeth find themselves up to their elbows in ice cream when Charley takes it upon himself to serve ice cream while his father is at a doctor's appointment. Charley learns that there are some responsibilities kids should not attempt to shoulder without the help of an adult.

## EPISODE 127

### 127a New Dog in Town

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Kind

In a heartwarming flashback story, we learn how Clifford's enormous size frightened T-Bone when they first met. T-Bone learns that "you can't judge a book by its cover"—friends come in all shapes and sizes.

### 127b Get Well

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be A Good Friend

Emily Elizabeth comes down with a bad cold, and Clifford and friends want to help her feel better. Using their imaginations and the resources around them, they create a card, collect flowers and fashion a small gift. When they present their offerings to Emily Elizabeth, it is obvious they have succeeded in making her feel cared for and loved. The dogs learn that it's the thought behind a gift that matters most.

## EPISODE 128

### 128a Babysitter Blues

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Kind

Mr. Bleakman is ready for a quiet relaxing weekend of oil painting, when he is asked to baby-sit Clifford for the day. Mr. Bleakman struggles to find a way to keep Clifford out of his way, but soon discovers that the big red dog has much to teach him about being spontaneous and having fun!

### 128b Saturday Morning

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be A Good Friend

When T-Bone's "special Saturday time" with Sheriff Lewis doesn't turn out the way he expected one week, he goes on a quest to see how others spend their Saturdays. He learns that there are many different ways to spend time with the people you love.

## EPISODE 129

### 129a Best Paw Forward

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

When cement is poured at the new Birdwell Island recreation center, the kids and dogs are invited to leave their handprints. But Clifford's paw print is just too big to stay! Seeing Clifford's disappointment, his friends work together to include Clifford.

### 129b Then Came Bob

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Play Fair

Vaz babysits for Bob - a cute, but not very well-behaved little dog that Dr. Dihn recently acquired from the dog pound. This little mischief-maker is very good at getting into trouble - and causing Clifford to get the blame! Emily Elizabeth never doubts her big dog for a minute, and the truth about Bob finally comes out.

## EPISODE 130

### 130a Morning, Noon, and Night

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect

Cleo and Clifford are excited to learn that Cleo will be Clifford's guest for a weekend while her house is being painted! But soon Cleo is filling Clifford's doghouse with her stuff, taking over his bed, and butting in on his time alone with Emily Elizabeth. It takes time, but Cleo eventually learns to be a good houseguest.

### 130b Mr. Bleakman's Special Day

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

Mr. Bleakman appears to be particularly grumpy one day. They overhear Mrs. Howard say that sometimes a grumpy attitude can be changed through kindness. This inspires the dogs to perform a series of "secret good deeds" to turn Mr. Bleakman's frown into a smile. They are surprised to learn that kind acts makes them feel much better too!

## EPISODE 131

### 131a Welcome To the Doghouse

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others; Be a Good Friend

In this flashback episode we see some of the challenges the Howards faced when they arrived on Birdwell Island with a very big, red dog! Where will Clifford live? How will they feed him? What will they use as his water dish? The folks of Birdwell Island work together to help the new arrivals solve their dilemmas, forging strong new friendships in the process.

### 131b Promises, Promises

CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

Jetta and Emily Elizabeth make plans to spend Saturday at the beach together, but Jetta breaks the play date when a "better offer" from an older girl comes along. However, when the older girl calls and cancels on Jetta, Jetta finally understands how Emily Elizabeth must have felt. She now realizes that being a good friend means keeping a promise.

## EPISODE 132

### 132a Clifford's Hiccups

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others; Be a Good Friend

Clifford gets a bad case of the hiccups - and that's a real problem with a dog the size of Clifford! His dog friends work together to come up with various remedies for Clifford. They are not successful and the hiccups eventually go away on their own. But Clifford expresses to his friends how good it feels to know they care so much about him.

### 132b It's My Party

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect; Be a Good Friend

When Jetta throws a "movie-watching" party, she expects everyone to do things her way - which in this case means watching home-movies of herself. The other kids try their best, but are soon bored and take a vote to go outside and make their own movie with Vaz's movie camera. Jetta is encouraged to join them, but stubbornly refuses. But she soon learns that it's more fun to play when everyone has a voice in deciding what to do together.

## EPISODE 133

### 133a Clifford Cleans His Doghouse

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Have Respect; Be a Good Friend

Clifford's good friends come over to help him clean out his doghouse, determined to get rid of all the old "junk" he no longer uses. But before long Clifford realizes that each item holds a special memory and can't be parted with. Mac thinks this is nonsense, until he is reminded of a memory in which he was included. He then understands, along with Clifford, that one dog's "junk" can be another dog's treasure.

### 133b And Baby Makes 4

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Share; Help Others

Jetta gets a new baby brother and at first is extremely proud to be a big sister. But when she realizes this means she will now have to share the spotlight with the baby, she goes all out to get back her position as the "center of attention." She eventually learns, however, that being a good "big sister" is far more rewarding than being the "star of the show."

## EPISODE 134

### 134a Jetta's Tall Tale

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

Jetta feels a twinge of jealousy when the other children make a fuss over Emily Elizabeth's wonderful big pet Clifford, so she blurts out a story about her own wonderful big pet - a huge parrot named Lulu. But the little lie quickly grows into a big mess, forcing Jetta to dress Clifford up as a bird to keep the lie from being exposed. Her conscience finally makes her do the right thing and she apologizes for having created the lie in the first place.

### 134b The Big Fetch

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others

Vaz is new at being a paperboy and is struggling with getting the papers onto people's doorsteps. Cleo steps in and discovers that she can earn treats by helping out! She recruits Clifford and T-bone and together they enjoy helping Vaz out - and getting treats. But before long Cleo has forgotten about the "helping out" part and is only concerned with getting treats. Clifford and T-bone help her rediscover that helping for its own sake is its own reward.

## EPISODE 135

### 135a Potluck Party Pooper

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend; Be Kind

The Howards are having a party and everyone they know will be attending. Everyone but Mr. Bleakman, that is. The old "party pooper" insists that he'd rather stay home and do his usual Saturday afternoon routine. But Clifford and Emily Elizabeth and her friends won't give up on trying to convince Mr. Bleakman that trying something new can be fun! Finally they are able to convince him to join them and a great time is had by all.

### 135b The Best Gift

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Believe in Yourself

Emily Elizabeth believes she has the perfect gift for her mother's birthday. She plans to spend the entire afternoon with her mother and the reading of a poem written just for her mom. Charley agrees that the gift is perfect, but Jetta has other ideas. Emily Elizabeth agrees to at least try some of Jetta's ideas. But in the end she realizes that the gift she created from her heart really is the best gift.

## EPISODE 136

### 136a Two's Company

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend

All of the dogs are so excited that their old friend K.C. is back on the island for a couple of days. Cleo, however, is particularly excited and focuses all of her attention on him - at the expense of ignoring T-bone and Clifford. She discovers that being a good friend means you should be kind and considerate to all your friends and not take any of them for granted.

### 136b Fairweather Friend

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be a Good Friend; Help Others

Mac is particularly disappointed when rainy weather threatens to ruin the upcoming Back-To-School Barbecue held every year at Jetta's house. The other dogs, seeing his disappointment, vow to find a way to stop the rain from falling. It doesn't take long for them to realize that you can't change the weather. But Mac's disappointment is replaced with delight that his friends would go to such lengths to try and help him.

## EPISODE 137

### 137a Doggie Garden

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Help Others; Work Together

It's "Keep Birdwell Beautiful" month and the kids are doing their part by planting a flower garden. Seeing this, the dogs decide to create a doggie flower garden of their own. But when Cleo hears that "almost anything grows" in Birdwell Island soil, she decides she'd much rather grow a garden full of dog toys! She soon learns, however, that working alone for a selfish end is not nearly as rewarding as working together for the whole community.

### 137b Captain's Birdwell's Treasure

#### CLIFFORD's Big Idea: Be Truthful

Clifford and his dog friends find the long-lost trunk of Captain Birdwell, filled with wonderful items brought to the Island by the explorer long ago. But through a misunderstanding, Jetta is given credit for the discovery. She knows that telling the truth is the right thing to do, but she can't resist the promise of a gold medal award.
